## Overview

EdR led the development of the first privatized collegiate housing project in the California State University (CSU) system at CSU-San Marcos. Working collaboratively with the university and the CSUSM Foundation, EdR designed, financed and constructed the three-story complex on time, under budget and 100% leased with a long waiting list.

Freshmen and transfer students live in two- and four-bedroom units with access to a 7,000-square-foot community building providing recreational and educational amenities as well as a classroom. Each building features an elevator and interior corridors. All units are handicap-accessible. Each floor has a laundry room and study/meeting rooms. The architecture complements the campus' existing design.

EdR also markets, manages, and maintains the facility as well as providing Residence Life programming in close cooperation with the university.
