



Overview

EdR, in association with Kensington Marquette Partners (KMP), brought convenience and high-end amenities to University of Michigan students via The Courtyards.

The development, adjacent to campus, offers residents park-like courtyards, a cyber café, recreational facilities, tanning capsules, quiet-study and meeting rooms, high-speed Internet access, cable television, a music practice room with a piano, outdoor badminton court and a mini-movie theater with surround sound.

Privacy is paramount with single-occupancy bedrooms, each with its own bathroom. Convenience is maximized through access to city and campus transportation.

EdR developed the property with KMP. EdR also manages it and provides residence life programming in concert with the university.
