## Overview

EdR replaced functionally obsolete dormitories in two phases at West Chester University of Pennsylvania. The first phase was completed in fall 2009 and the second phase was completed in 2014. In all, 1,850 beds of modern housing are now available to students.

EdR was selected by The West Chester University Student Housing Foundation to replace the old dormitories. The new housing offers unique opportunities that have dramatically strengthened the university's residential community as well as its special-interest housing programs.





The housing has significantly enhanced the university's ability to attract and retain top students. The new state-of-the-art housing community blends in with the character and style of campus' traditional buildings, yet also reflects the university's forward-looking character.
